

Valentine Keepsakes

The stamp set isn't just for Valentines!

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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Valentine Keepsakes (154354)
- **Cardstock (or “CS”)**: Misty Moonlight (153081); Basic White (159276); Granny Apple Green (146990); Rich Razzleberry (115316)
- **Ink Pads**: Misty Moonlight (153118); Granny Apple Green (147095)
- **Miscellaneous**: Oh So Ombre Designer Series Paper (or “DSP”)(155225); Layering Circles Dies (151770); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Paper Snips (103579); Paper Trimmer (152392); Stampin’ Cut & Emboss Machine (149653)



Measurements:

- Misty Moonlight CS: 5 ½” x 8 ½” scored in half at 4 ¼”; 5” x 3-3/4”; 3” x 1/2”
- Granny Apple Green CS: 2-3/4” x 1/2”
- Basic White CS: 5” x 3-3/4”; scrap for die cutting
- Rich Razzleberry CS: scrap of die cutting
- DSP: 1-1/4” x 3-3/4” (4 pieces)

Instructions:

1. Stamp small hearts onto each piece of DSP in Misty Moonlight, staggering where the hearts are on the different pieces.
2. Stamp the sentiment in Misty Moonlight onto a scrap of Basic White CS.
3. Stamp the heart-flowers in Granny Apple Green onto the Basic White CS for the inside.
4. Snip the ends of the two ½” strips at an angle using Paper Snips.
5. Using the Layering Circles Dies, cut the sentiment, and a larger circle from the scrap of Rich Razzleberry CS.
6. Glue the four DSP pieces onto the 5” x 3-3/4” piece of Misty Moonlight CS. Trim away any ugly edges.
7. Glue the DSP piece onto the front of the card base.
8. Glue the two ½” CS strips onto the DSP layer.
9. Glue the sentiment onto the Rich Razzleberry CS circle, then glue that over the straight end of the CS strips.
10. Glue the Basic White CS onto the inside of the card base.
