

Simply Said Mix & Match

Glass & Garden Emboss Technique

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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** - Simply Said Mix & Match (163756)
- **Paper** – Basic White (166780); Poppy Parade (119793); Lemon Lime Twist (144245); Balmy Blue (146982)
- **Stamp Pads** –Tuxedo Black Memento Ink (132708); Poppy Parade (147050); Lemon Lime Twist (147145); Balmy Blue (147105)
- **Miscellaneous** – Nested Essentials Dies (161597); Glass & Gardens Embossing Folders (165597), Starburst Sequins (165539); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)



Measurements:

- Poppy Parade: 8 ½" x 4 ¼"; scored at 4 ¼"
- Lemon Lime Twist: 5 ½" x 2 ¾"
- Basic White: 5 ½" x 2 ½"
- Balmy Blue: 3" x 2"

Instructions:

1. Fold Poppy Parade at 4 ¼" to form card base.
2. Emboss the Basic White using the Glass & Gardens Embossing Folder and the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine.
3. Turn the piece over to the "debossed" side
4. Gently drag the Poppy Parade, Lemon Lime Twist and Balmy Blue over the piece to create the color pattern.
5. Glue the piece to the Lemon Lime Twist.
6. Cut out the banner die from Balmy Blue using the Nested Essentials Dies.
7. Stamp the sentiment on the bottom of the banner in Memento Black ink.
8. Glue the banner to the back of the Lemon Lime Twist on the right side.
9. Glue the pieces to the card base.
10. Embellish with sequins to finish the card.
